We are looking for an energetic, dynamic, friendly and creative person to support our Emergency Food Programs staff with the Food Bank, Drop-in and Good Food Market programs and activities.

Responsibilities:

Assist the Food Bank and Drop-In team with the following tasks:

- Facilitate Good Food Market every Tuesday
- Support, Pizza Oven and Good Food Market volunteers
- Complete administrative tasks associated with the Good Food Market (food ordering, accounting, statistics etc.)
- Support food bank and drop-in service delivery and programming
- Support and provide outreach for special community events, field trips and workshops

Qualifications:

- Experience working with volunteers and community members in a leadership capacity
- Commitment to social justice and knowledge of food system issues
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Demonstrated ability to work with and show sensitivity to those who experience poverty/discrimination
- Demonstrated ability to work within a diverse community (people of different ages, abilities and cultural backgrounds)
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds and work in a fast paced environment
- Ability to speak a language relevant to the neighbourhood is an asset
